## ANAS ADOPTS A COMMUNICATIVE APPROACH TO THE TEACHING OF ARABIC LANGUAGE

### Arabic 101 (Fall)

Arabic 101 is an Introduction to Modern Standard Arabic. By the end of Arabic 101, students will:

1. Have mastered the Arabic alphabet.
2. Be able to recognize and pronounce correctly all Arabic sounds, and write accurately from dictation;
3. Be able to initiate social interactions and ask for basic information.
4. Be able to talk and compose simple information about yourself, your education, and your family with native speakers.
5. Comprehend simple print texts, and audio-video on familiar topics.
6. Learn vocabulary of about 300 words.

### Arabic 102 (Spring)

Arabic 102 is the second in a series of Arabic language courses offered by ANAS. The prerequisite for the course is Arabic 101 or its equivalent. Just like Arabic 101, this course will be proficiency based, covering all language skills (speaking, listening, reading, and writing). We will place considerable emphasis on active use of the language both in class and in daily homework assignments. By the end of the course, students can expect to become able to read simple texts using a limited range of vocabulary and structures, to deliver a more sophisticated introduction about oneself in Arabic, and to engage in limited conversations with classmates, instructor and native speakers.
